## 2024 Department Convention Voting

Chairmen of post delegations should check with the Headquarters staff at the Convention Registration Desk at the North Raleigh Hilton upon arrival in Raleigh to be sure that their Post delegates are properly certified. In accordance with Article V Section 9 of the Department Constitution and By-Laws, only those Posts whose delegates are duly certified and whose registration fee has been paid will be permitted to vote in the Department elections. The pre-registration fee is \$10.00 per delegate. Registration at the Convention will be \$12.00 per delegate. Certification for delegates must be received at headquarters no later than **June 11, 2024**.

Be sure to get a copy of the convention schedule at the Legion registration desk upon arrival as there may be last minute updates on meeting room and time changes.

## Post Commander/Adjutant Packets

This year we are again endeavoring to get an early start on our 2024-2025 membership program. In order to do this, it is imperative we get the Commander and Adjutant packets and 2025 membership cards into the proper hands as soon as possible. The packets will be ready for you to pick up during the Department Convention, June 19-22, in the Judicial room, the same as our registration at the North Raleigh Hilton, Raleigh, NC. **Please be sure to sign for your packet and give your Post number so that we can determine who has not received a packet. *If it is impossible for you to attend the Convention, please make arrangements with someone from your Post or one nearby to pick up your packet. If a nearby post is picking them up, please let us know prior to convention. Any cards not picked up will be mailed and billed to the post.***

Please make sure that your post members are aware of the enhanced **NO COST** benefit of the new Legion Care. **FREE AD&D** insurance. Just fill out the form and mail it in for coverage. Nothing is automatic, so you must mail the form. **\$5,000** in accidental Death coverage for covered accidents that occur if you are traveling on official Legion business. **\$1000.00** for all other covered accidents. 24/7 protection that covers Legionnaires at home, work or while they are traveling away from home. This is available to all "**current**" Legion members. This is one thing that you just do not want to "put off".
